



24th Endurance Regularity Rally «24 Hours Greece»

16-17 October 2021

Central Greece – Thessaly

On October 16, the "24 Hours Greece", the only one of its kind endurance rally for historical cars, starts for the 24th consecutive year!

Eligible are up to ninety historic cars & youngtimers and they will start at 11 am from Chalkida towards Loukisia, Loutsis, Modi and Loutra Ypatis. After one hour of re group, the special stages of Agios Georgios of the mountain Timfristos, Fournas of Evrytania and the western side of Lake Plastiras with Arapis & the Dam follow. At around 9 pm, the crews will start arriving in Karditsa, where the three-hour night re group of the 24th Rally "24 Hours Greece" will take place.

At midnight the determined crews will be confronted with the night special routes on the east side of Lake Plastiras, Mesenikolas, Rachoula & Neraida. Continuation with Klitsos, Platanos, Fournas, Paleokastro and then Lamia for one hour re group. At 5 in the morning begins the 4th and last leg with the specials of Central Greece, Bralos, Apostolias, Dadi, Fterolakka & the Ritsona downhill. Upon the completion of 800 kilometers distance & 24 hours duration the crews will finish in Chalkida.

A few words about the endurance rally "24 Hours Greece":

- This rally is addressed to well-prepared drivers and co-drivers of historic cars who want to experience a 24-hour adventure on the legendary routes of Greece. The race is conducted according to FIVA regulations on open to traffic yet remote roads.
- All certified historic cars over 30 years old are accepted, as well as "youngtimer" 20-29 years old. Safety measures (eg roll cage) are not necessary, but they are acceptable.
- A racing license is not required, but driver's license, car insurance and roadside assistance are mandatory.
- The duration of the rally from the start to the finish is 24 hours and in between there will be 2 one-hour stops as well as 1 three-hour re group for rest. The required distance to be covered is 800 km and the participants will compete in 22 special stages, with over 70 timings.
- In the category Touring Trophy & the "12 Hours Greece" trophy compete the crews who do not want to overestimate their strengths, but want to live this unique experience. Slightly fewer kilometers and selectively lower average hourly speeds are provided for the Touring Trophy category.
- For the execution of the special stages, advanced navigation instruments are not required and a good odometer and a stopwatch are enough. All distance, time or navigation instruments are free to use!
- All distances, average hourly speeds and timing points of special stages are notified on time. In this rally wireless satellite timing with live results is used.

Registrations have already started and the deadline for entries is Friday, October 8th, while the deadline for participation with a reduced entry fee expires on September 25th.
