

## Dear participants,

please read the following instructions carefully so that you all have an equal chance of distinction and for a safe finish.

The administrative, technical control & the distribution of material will take place according to the posted schedule on the Club's official website **www.sisa.gr** 

- A GPS Timing Sensor (Transponder) & Live Tracking with autonomous battery will be installed in your vehicles by the Organization. Willful interference with the operation of the sensor of the timing system is prohibited under penalty of disqualification.
- If for any reason it is not possible to obtain the time from a crew's transponder, then the marshals will decide the fairest way to allocate time to that crew. This decision will be final and not subject to appeal!
- Don't forget that you are participating in a regularity event on public open roads! Respect the law, other drivers & pedestrians and of course other participants.
- The requested Average Hourly Speeds on provincial roads do not exceed 50 km/h, those that pass through residential areas are below 40 km/h, while those that pass through gravel roads due to necessity, will not exceed 20 km/h. On sections of national roads & highways the av. speed can reach up to 80 km.
- Passages through villages are subject to speed controls.
  1<sup>st</sup> violation: warning, 2<sup>nd</sup> violation: warning, 3<sup>rd</sup> violation: DISQUALIFICATION
- This rally goes through a typical mountain network and always be alert for road damage and rocks from landslides. Do not forget that on country roads and Special Stages you may encounter domestic or wild animals and the risk of collision is high.
- The Road Book is written with great accuracy but there may be small deviations in the distances, which do not affect the correctness of the route or ideal times of the special stages.
- Read carefully the pronouncements of the special stages. All ideal times are achievable!
- It is forbidden to completely stop the vehicle at least 50 meters before the time control points (check points) within the Special Stages. The vehicle should be moving at a constant speed when passing them, otherwise you may be awarded an early passage time.
- The Organizing Committee reserves the right without warning & explanation to merge special stages or parts of them and add up the ideal times, as well as to cancel or not count parts of them.
- In the event that before or within a Special Stage or before Time Control Stations you are not sure what to do or in the event that a following participant's vehicle persistently tries to pass you, then a) let this vehicle pass you, b) do not block the start line and c) do not block the crossing or the check point. Otherwise, obstructing another participant may be considered unsportsmanlike behavior and may even result in disqualification!
- Always respect the priorities among participants' categories. Article 11.2 of f the Regulations.
- Any overtaking within a gravel stage is prohibited under penalty of disqualification, unless the vehicle in front agrees consents. Spinning is also prohibited at the beginning of the Special Stages & within the gravel routes because they may cause damage to the vehicles following.
- Any deliberate deviation from the course of the Route Book and not due to reasons of force majeure, noted by the marshals, is prohibited under penalty of disqualification. We remind you that your vehicle has a GPS transmitter and your course is monitored throughout the rally. Touring Trophy category is excluded from this rule when different instructions are given.
- In regroups & restarts respect the other participants, do not obstruct other drivers and do not block the roads.
- In regroupings, do not consume alcoholic beverages during the competitive part!
- This rally is judged on endurance, tactics & accuracy. To stand out, first you have to finish! Never risk an accident that will endanger your physical integrity & damage your car.
